Fundraising Policy & Guidelines



I. Purpose

The purpose of this document is to provide fundraising policies and guidelines for the Ka'oi Cyclones. Fundraising profits will be used to offset team and individual expenses including (but not limited to) travel, tournaments, uniforms and equipment.

II. Fundraising Committee

The fundraising committee will be comprised of:

- a) President
- b) Vice-President
- c) Event Chair
- d) Treasurer
- e) Secretary

III. Participation

Parent and player participant is vital in ensuring a successful fundraising event. Most fundraisers will require the participation of both the player and at least one (1) parent/adult. (See section VI for details). Participation is required to assist the Fundraising Committee in planning and coordinating fundraising events. Each family will be required to volunteer to chair a fundraising event each season. It is highly recommended that players and parents participate in the team fundraising events as these are also ideal opportunities for team-building/bonding as well.

Failure to participate in fundraising activities may result in releasing the player from the travel team.

New/Mid-Season Players: If a new player joins the team mid-season, the player will be required to deposit funds into the team's account to match the amount that existing players have already earned for the team. Example: If 10 players deposited a total of \$1,000 into the team account, the new player joining the team will be required to deposit \$100 into the team account upon becoming a member.

Guest Players: Guest players will not be required to match existing funds in the team account, however, will be required to pay their portion of all team and individual expenses related to the tournament they are guest playing in.

Withdrawal from the Team: Players who voluntarily or involuntarily withdraw from the team will not receive a distribution of their contribution to the team account. The withdrawing player will receive all of the proceeds accumulated in their individual account within a reasonable time after withdrawing from the team.

IV. Fundraising Profit Distribution

Team Account: Profits will be used to offset expenses that benefit the team, including (but not limited to):

- Team van / gas
- Team meals/snacks
- Laundry
- Team activities
- Goodwill/ tournament gifts
- Coaches expenses (to be determined).

Individual account: Profit earned by an individual player may be used to offset the player's individual soccer expenses, including but not limited to contributions toward team expenses, uniforms, training, etc, at the parent's or coaches' discretion. Any remaining balance will be distributed at the end of the season.

The Committee Treasurer is charged with managing all financial transactions related to maintaining the team and individual accounts; including communication and collections.

V. Team Fundraising Requirements

Some fundraisers (garage sale, car wash, Wal-mart) will require one parent or adult to participate. For these fundraisers, if the player shows up without parent/adults, the player will not be allowed to participate in the event and will be required to deposit the same amount of funds the event earned per player into the team account. (Example: A fundraiser results in \$50 team profit/player. The non-participating player will be required to deposit \$50 into the teams account).

Prior to a fundraising event, the Committee will determine if the event will be mandatory for the parent and player. There may be some events that the fundraising committee will allow the parent and player to deposit funds into the team's account voluntarily in lieu of participation.

When a fundraiser is agreed upon by the team, it will be determined at that time how many items or tickets the player must sell for the team account. For selected fundraiser events, players may be given the opportunity to sell additional items or tickets; of which the profit will be deposited into the individual player's account.
